Mastoera Sadan

Mastoera Sadan played a key role in the production of South Africa's 20 year review and has contributed to the background papers regarding children. She is the programme manager of the Programme to Support Pro-poor Policy Development Phase II (PSPPD II), which is located within the National Planning Commission (NPC) in the Presidency. In addition to the PSPPD Phase II, she manages the National Income Dynamics Study (NIDS) for the Presidency - South Africa's national household panel study. Mastoera Sadan is a doctoral candidate at Rhodes University. She was a Visiting Scholar at the University of Oxford in 2002/03. She holds an MSc from the London School of Economics.

About the topic

The Twenty Year Review provides an evaluation of the policies instituted by government since the advent of democracy. While highlighting achievements, it also addresses shortcomings and looks at initiatives and operational plans for the future. Ms. Sadan will look specifically at the development of child related policy through a 20-year lens, elaborating on how far we have come and comment on the future of child policy in South Africa.
